For Group Discussion:

1. Why do people think sin is no big deal to God?
2. Let's expand on the analogy between "kryptonite's" lethality to Superman and the deadly affect some activities/practices can have on followers of Jesus. Superman would always avoid exposure to kryptonite, unless risking his life would save another; other than that, he would never knowingly expose himself to such danger. Why do some make conscious choices to expose themselves to that which they know can result in "death" – walking away from God's protection and path?
