Text: Matthew 1:1-5:1

For Group discussion:

1. Was there benefit for you in scanning the first 4 chapters of Matthew in preparation for examining The Sermon? If so, discuss how Matthew 1-4 will help us understand more fully The Sermon as we examine it over the next several weeks.
2. Cf. Matthew 4:18-22 and discuss how the call of Jesus to follow him disrupts and changes our lives.
3. Discuss how life in the kingdom of heaven is distinctively different from the "kingdom" of this world. Delve into some specifics. You might even want to glance through The Sermon and discuss some topics it raises.
4. From the sermon (my sermon): "You cannot live outside the kingdom of heaven on earth and expect to be welcomed into the kingdom of God in eternity." Discuss the eternal jeopardy many find themselves in because they don't understand or ignore that great truth.
